The Jerusalem Arbitration Center, backed by the International Chamber of Commerce, was launched on 18 November 2013. It was created as a neutral and efficient forum for dispute resolution between Israeli and Palestinian business actors. The underlying idea for the project is in line with that developed by the French philosopher Montesquieu, namely that the development of trade leads to peace. The cornerstones of the Center are neutrality, efficiency, and modernity. As a result, the Jerusalem Arbitration Center has emerged as a unique institution that is classical yet avant-garde – the first of its kind in a conflict zone.
