"A Few Concrete Questions Related to Intermediated Securities from a Comparative Law Perspective"

As moving around masses of paper has many disadvantages, securities have become alternately or cumulatively dematerialized and immobilized. Such securities are held, transferred, lent and pledged across borders to a significant extent. They are held by intermediaries in (cross-border) chains. We shall discuss questions concerning the transfer of title and good faith acquisition from a comparative law perspective (incl. the UNIDROIT Convention on Intermediated Securities, which, however, has not been implemented yet).
